

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is made at Pune on 28th September, 2021

BETWEEN

Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana college having its Registered Office at Off. Eastern Express Highway, Dnyanasadhana Marg, Thane(W), Maharashtra hereinafter referred to as "College" (Which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the First Part,

AND

GTT Foundation a Non-Profit Organization registered having its registered office at 10, Talera Park, Kalyani Nagar, Pune-411014 hereinafter referred to as "GTTF" (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the subject or context thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns) of the Second Part

WHEREAS:

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- 1. Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana college is an is an Educational institution affiliated to the Mumbai University
- 2. GTT Foundation is engaged in the field of education & employability domain that provides training to the students as part of their CSR activity
- 3. Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana college is willing to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with GTTF for the skills enhancement training program through the technology platform or other face to face initiatives.



NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

1. Objective:

The objective of this MOU is to enable students of **the college** access to resources that would enhance their employability.

2. Period of MOU:

This MOU shall come into force and effect from the date of execution and shall remain valid for a period of Two year from such date after which the same may be reviewed by either party. However, if the same is not renewed this arrangement will be deemed terminated on the expiry of the said duration period.

3. Roles & Responsibilities of the College:

- a. The College shall be responsible to nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the engagement. The person so appointed would act as the single point of contact (SPOC) for the proposed initiative.
- b. The College shall share in their letterhead the details of the students who will attend the aforesaid training program with GTTF like name, email ID, contact details, Name of the Company in which Candidate is placed(current Company), qualification (along with the year of completion/pursuing) and other documents as per GTTF training requirements..
- c. It would be the responsibility of the College to ensure that proper publicity of the Program is made through College website.
- d. To encourage the Students to register for the Program by informing them about $\sqrt{10}$ the benefits of the program.



- e. **College** to refrain conducting any of their training or call with the students when GTTF training is going on.
- f. It would be their responsibility to ensure that all their students adhere to training schedule.
- g. To provide all the support services and facilities to GTTF during the conduct of the said Training Program.
- h. To coordinate with GTTF and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by GTTF, as per schedule communicated by GTTF.
- i. To provide the placement details of the students who have undergone the aforesaid training.

4. Roles & Responsibilities of GTTF:

- a. GTTF shall be responsible to provide access to employability enhancement related activities through blended learning model.
- b. GTTF will arrange for assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.
- c. GTTF will facilitate placement of students with their client/ customer companies in suitable positions and also recruit for their own requirements.

5. Other Terms & Conditions:

Following are the other terms and conditions of MOU:

- a. The students enrolled should complete the training as scheduled.
- b. The students should register as per the process of GTTF
- c. Program Coordinator to be appointed by college



- d. TPO's active support and participation is required for smooth & efficient conduct of the program.
- e. The College shall not write/publish any material or use any logos/names of GTTF/ in any of the publications without prior written consent and approval from GTTF.

6. Commercials:

This life skills enhancement **training program** is free of cost. GTTF shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the students or the College for conducting the aforesaid training program.

7. Certification:

Certificates shall be awarded by GTTF to the students on successful completion of the training and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the training program.

8. Limitations and Warranties :

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavor to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MOU terms by the other party.

9. Termination:

- a. Both parties can terminate the MOU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms or non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MOU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
- b. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programs, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.



10. Entirety & Amendment:

This MOU contains the entire understanding between the Parties in relation to the Training Program. If during the operation of the MOU, circumstances may rise which call for alteration / modification to this MOU, such alteration / modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MOU. Any changes/amendments to this MOU not in conformance to this section shall be deemed to be void-ab-initio.

11. Intellectual Proprietary Rights:

All intellectual or proprietary property and information, supplied or developed by either Party shall be and remain the sole and exclusive property of the Party who supplied or developed same. Upon termination of this MOU and upon written request, the Party in receipt of the requesting Party's intellectual or proprietary property and/or information pursuant to this MOU shall return such information to the requesting Party.

12. Confidential Information:

C.A.

- a. Both parties undertake to each other to keep confidential all information (written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of the other, which has been obtained or received during the course(s) of performance hereunder, save that which is inconsequential or obvious;
- b. Already in its possession other than as a result of a breach of this clause; or in the hands of the public other than as a result of a breach of this clause.
 - In the event of any of the parties becoming legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such party shall give sufficient notice to the other party



so as to enable the other party to seek a timely protective order or any other appropriate relief. If such an order or other relief cannot be obtained, the party being required to make such a disclosure shall make the disclosure of the Confidential Information only to the extent that is legally required of it and no further.

d. The College agrees not to deal directly or enter into any agreement any clients GTTF and should not share any information with them related to the training during the term of the agreement and also after the agreement have been terminated, not earlier than two years from the date of termination.

13. Force Majeure:

- a. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
- b. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.



14. Non-Solicitation:

The College agrees that during the term of this Agreement and for a period of two (2) years after the termination or expiry thereof, it shall not, directly or indirectly, employ, contract, solicit, hire or otherwise utilize the services of an existing employee of GTTF.

15. Jurisdiction and Arbitration:

- a. In the event of any dispute or difference between the Parties hereto, the courts in Pune alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any matter arising between the Parties here-to and accordingly both the Parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Pune, Maharashtra.
- b. Any dispute arising out of, in relation to or in respect to this MOUshall be settled through mutual consultation and agreement, by the Parties to this MOU. In case a settlement is not arrived at within fifteen (15) days of reference, the dispute/s shall be referred to a sole arbitrator to be appointed in accordance to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. The place of arbitration shall be Pune, India.

THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana College, Thane- 400604

&

Vijnan Bharati, Mumbai- 400028

For the cooperation in the activities related to science popularization, and education and research in science

WHEREAS Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana College (herein after referred to as the College) having its office at Off Eastern Express Highway, Dnyanasadhana Marg, Thane- 400604, is a highly reputed college affiliated to the University of Mumbai, in Thane city offering quality education at graduate and post-graduate levels

WHEREAS the Vijnan Bharati (Konkan Prant), Mumbai (herein after referred to as the Vibha), having its office at 1st floor, Pitruchhaya, Paralkar Marg, Shivaji Park, Dadar, Mumbai 400028, is a division of Vijnan Bharati, a national Non-Government Organization dedicated to popularization of science and inculcating the spirit of science among masses, with special emphasis on indigenous scientific developments, and believing in harnessing the fruits of science through innovation for improving the life of the people and further believing in the principles of sustainability.

WHEREAS the College and the Vibha believe that the national development strongly depends on the quality of education in our country and motivation of the youth of this country, and further believe that education plays main role in shaping the future of our country.

NOW THEREFORE the College and the Vibha have intended, agreed and consented to the following terms and conditions in pursuance of our common interests of promoting science in our society, and encourage & motivate students and teachers.

OBJECTIVES

1. This **Memorandum of Understanding** (MoU) sets for the terms and understanding between the College and the Vibha giving the guidelines for the cooperation between the parties for the implementation of the following objectives of the MoU.

(a) To promote Basic Sciences and Research

(b) To develop interest of students in Basic Sciences.

(c) To inculcate scientific temper amongst students.

(d) To conduct various activities like Expert Talk, Poster Presentation, Quiz and Exhibitions, Projects, Career Counselling, Field Visits.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MOU

2. The College and the Vibha hereby agree to work together for all the activities related to the MoU. Further, both the parties agree to share all responsibilities related to the MoU and arising out of the implementation of the MoU.

3. The Principal of the College and the General Secretary of the Vibha shall be responsible for giving shape to and the execution of the MoU. They may meet periodically to initiate, plan, monitor, and collect the feedback on the activities executed under this MoU.

4. Both the partners will take a collective decision of incorporating additional partners, if required, after mutual discussion. The additional partners may be incorporated to increase the visibility of the activities, to introduce additional features in the proposed activities or to share limited responsibilities. Such a new addition will be suitably recorded with the role to be played.

5. The College and the Vibha will take all steps to popularize the events to be conducted.

6. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure, if any, shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.

DURATION

7. This MOU shall become effective from the date of the MoU and shall remain valid for an initial period of three years. The MOU may be extended by mutual consent.

AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION

8. This MoU may be amended from time to time by mutual consent.

9. This MOU may be terminated by either side by giving a notice of three month to that effect in writing to the other party. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the MOU, any commitments already made under the MOU before its lapse or termination needs to be fulfilled.

10. Any difficulty encountered in the implementation of the MOU will be reported to the respective coordinators who will take appropriate decisions, after consulting the respective authorities. The decision taken will be final.

11. This MOU is subjected to the jurisdiction of the judicature of the Mumbai High Court.

Mudra Creation a Sole Proprietor firm, through its Proprietor Manish Waghmare & Sayali Jadhav (PAN No: ACTPW9491 & BNKPJ8513P, residing at Mulund East, hereafter referred to as "Mudra Creation" (which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors in title and assigns)

Dnyanasadhana and Mudra Creation are here inafter collectively referred to as the "Parties" and singularly as a "Party", as the case may be.

WHEREAS

- Dnyanasadhana, Thane owns and runs a College name "Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana College, Thane" (hereinafter referred to as "Premises") in Thane, which is situated at Dnyanasadhana Marg, Near Eastern Express Highway, Thane (W) – 400604.
- 2. Mudra Creation is engaged in the business of Teaching Dances.
- 3. The Parties desire to enter into MOU at the mutually acceptable terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to record the terms and conditions of MOU in writing.

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

1. TERM

This MOU shall come into force from the midnight of 11th April 2022 and shall be in force till the midnight of 10th April 2023 unless terminated earlier by Both parties.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

- a. Dnyanasadhana, Thane is the sole and undisputed owner of the duly constructed premises of Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana College, Thane situated at Dnyanasadhana Marg, Near Eastern Express Highway, Thane (W) 400 604, Dnyanasadhana, Thane hereby permits Mudra Creations to use Dnyanasadhana's premises such as terrace for teachers dance classes and pisavaram for students dance classes.
- b. Working hours

For students 2 days a week such as Monday and Tuesday from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

For Teachers 3 days a week such as Thursday ,Friday and Saturday from 12:30p.m. to 2:00 p.m.

3. TERMINATION

This MOU may be terminated by Both the parties at any time during the tenure of this MOU, by giving 30 days' prior Notice to Eachother.

4. Fees

The Fees should be as follows:

• Fees Per Student – 750₹

550₹ for Dance instructors and 200₹ for Dnyanasadhana, Thane as a donation per student from Mudra Creation.

• Fees Per Teacher -1000₹

700₹ for Dance Instructors and 300₹ for Dnyanasadhana, Thane as a donation per teacher from Mudra Creation.

5. OTHER TERMS

- a. This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Indian law and for disputes between the parties under this MOU the Courts of Thane shall have exclusive Jurisdiction.
- b. Any changes to this MOU shall be recorded by the Parties in writing ad shall have full force and effect only after both the Parties sign and agree to the amended terms.
- c. The Parties intend to give this MOU a legal and binding effect, same as a valid Agreement between the Parties.
- d. This MOU cannot be assigned to any third Party, without prior written consent from the other Party.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (herein after called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 27th day of April month 2022 (Date 27-04-2022), by and between **ExcelR Solutions**,

(Here in after referred as 'First Party')

And

Satish Pradhan Dnyanasadhana College, Thane

(Here in after referred to as 'Second Party') (First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

- 1. First Party is a EdTech company: ExcelR Solutions
- 2. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- 3. The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- 4. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

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NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 7. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
- 8. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the second party on various trending technologies.
- 9. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the student internships of second party on various trending technologies of minimum four weeks duration.
- 10. ExcelR will reach out to students to communicate about course details, webinars, blogs, industry events etc., which will be informative or promotional in nature.
- 11. Training & Development and dissemination of knowledge for students of second party & affiliated colleges and employees of both the organizations.
- 12. ExcelR would work with incubation centers/ innovation cells of second party (Case to case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party

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13. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 14. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 15. Curriculum Design: First Party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 16. Software Technologies Training: The first party will provide the trainings to the students and Faculties of the second party on different technologies like Data Science, Data Analyst, Artificial Intelligence, Tableau, Python, etc., Research and Development
- 17. Skill Development Programs: First Party to train the students of second Party on the emerging technologies to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 18. Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 19. Faculty Development Programs: First Party to train the faculties of second Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 20. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 21. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enroll the students and faculties for the different free trainings run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation.

ExcelR Solution

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- 22. First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of second party and at the discretion of first party.
- 23. In case, second party wants to conduct customized commercial trainings then this agreement can be amend/adding annexure with mutually agreed terms.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 24. Both Parties shall have the sole rights on the respective curriculum, logos, Intellectual Property and related content provided in the trainings and it cannot be replicated or copied without the consent of respective parties sharing the same.
- 25. Confidentiality: Except as may otherwise be required by law, each party will hold confidential, during and after the term of this Agreement, any confidential information disclosed to it or its representatives, and will not disclose any such confidential information to any third party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 26. The period of the agreement is valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing of this agreement
- 27. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or cancelled by either party any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

28. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
