Annual report 2020-2021

Due to Corona Pandemic, Teaching learning setup underwent a huge change. Some steps were taken to introduce online teaching learning.

In the month of May, different stakeholders were busy in preparation of the same. It was decided to use MS Teams for online teaching learning. Hands on training was given for the same. First session on training of MS Teams for teaching learning process was conducted on 11 July. Second session was conducted on 14th July and third session on 19th July.

Institutional email ID was given to all the teaching members and non teaching staff members. Online Admission for Second and Third year started in third week of July. Inhouse merit list for first year aided courses was uploaded on website on 26th July 2020. Online videos for admission process in English and Marathi was made and circulated among students. Results of 6th Semester were declared. The results ranged between 90 to 100% of all the courses.

Mrs S.P Deuskar was appointed as Vice Principal in Commerce faculty on August 4th 2020. Dr Kuduk was appointed as Vice Principal of Arts faculty, Dr Mrunal Bakane was appointed as Vice Principal of science faculty and Dr Shraddha Bhome was appointed as Vice Principal of Self Finance Faculty. Online teaching of SY and TY started on 7th August. On 31st December 21, Dr C.D. Marathe successfully completed his Principalship term and the baton was handed over to equally competent Dr H.K Chitte. Two staff members, Dr D.B Bhangade and Mrs Smita Shevde of senior aided section retired after their glorious service. Vaccination drive was started in the month of April for teaching and Non-Teaching staff.

Glorious Events:

The college has completed 40 glorious years in the field of education and now become a prominent institute in the Thane region. To celebrate the Ruby Jubilee year, it has been decided to organise 40 unique programmes from different fields from August 2020 to May 2021.
