Organizing dept from our college: Environmental studies, BBI, CS, IT


Project coordinators: Dr. Sanjyot Deuskar, head dept. Of Environmental studies and vice principal, Commerce faculty.

Delegate Policy:

Delegate Policy SPDCMUN'23

The SPDCMUN'23 will be held on 18th and 19th of February, 2023 in the Satish Pradhan Dyansadhana College, Thane. Below is the delegate policy for the MUN, all participants are requested to read and adhere by them.

- During the conference, each registered SPDCMUN'23 participant will be representing a member-state and will be referred to as a 'Delegate'.
- 2. Decorum:
 - a. Delegates are expected to treat each other with the utmost respect, just as any other member of the diplomatic community would.
 - b. Delegates should be aware that they must speak in the third person during all modes of formal discussion.
 - c. Delegates are should exercise diplomatic courtesy when addressing members of the committee and the dais during the sessions.
 - d. Delegates must also be courteous to all committee staff and organising committee members.
 - e. Delegates are requested to attend all formal committee sessions in the committee's assigned room only.
- The delegates will be held liable for any intentional or negligent damage to the property, as well as the venues and premises.
- 4. The usage of English and Hindi languages will be permitted.
- 5. Internet, Electronic devices and Social Media:

- a. Apart from the permitted usage, the use of the aforementioned electronic devices during formal sessions is prohibited.
- Delegates should not access social media and their personal correspondence during the formal discussions.
- c. Internet connection and electronic devices will not be provided by the organizers.

Dress code:

- a. First day Indian Formals
- b. Second day -Western Formals

Indecent clothing is strictly prohibited.

7. Sexual harassment and Discrimination policy:

The SPDCMUN'23 will not tolerate any case of sexual harassment and discrimination on the basis of gender, sexuality, socio-economic background, religion, etc. against any delegate, member of the executive board or the organizing committee. If any delegate feels that they have been a victim of any of the above, they are requested to report it to the Executive Board or any member of the Secretariat. The matter will be investigated and appropriate action will be taken.

8. Consumption of intoxicating substances:

Even minor amounts of drug and/or alcohol consumption or possession will not be tolerated. If a delegate is discovered to be in possession of alcohol or drugs, he or she will be asked to leave the conference immediately. Policy violators may face criminal charges. Smoking is not permitted on college grounds.

- In the event of extreme or unavoidable circumstances such as health epidemics, major natural disasters, or vis major, SPDCMUN'23 reserves the right to cancel the conference.
- 10. SPDCMUN'23 IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ITEMS LEFT IN COUNCIL ROOMS AFTER A COMMITTEE DAY. Delegates are advised to keep valuable electronic items, cash purses/wallets, and other valuables in their possession or secure them in their bags.
- 11.After the conclusion of a committee day, SPDCMUN'23 is NOT RESPONSIBLE for any items left in council rooms. It is advised for delegates to keep their valuable electronics, wallets, and other items with them at all times or to store them safely in their bags.


