Programme Specific Outcome (PSOs)

PSO 3 - Students will acquire specialized knowledge of regional histories, including the history of Maharashtra and the Marathas, enabling them to understand the unique cultural, political, and economic developments within specific regions of India from 1630 CE to 1960 CE.

PSO 4 - Through courses like Introduction to Archaeology, Museology and Archival Science, and Heritage Tourism, students will develop practical skills in historical research, preservation, and the promotion of heritage. This will prepare them for careers in archaeology, museums, archives, and heritage management.

PSO 5 - Students will enhance their critical thinking and research skills by engaging with various historical methodologies and sources. They will learn to analyze historical evidence, construct well-supported historical arguments, and contribute original research to the field of history, particularly in areas such as the socio-economic history of modern India and the contemporary world (1945 CE – 2000 CE).
