She focused on report writing preparation strategies, including literature reviews.

Asst. Prof. Mrs. Shobhana Nadar, the session's guest speaker, was introduced. The statistical tools available for the data analysis were described by Madam. She explained the usage of each technique and provided a range of examples, including the T test, F test, Chi-square test, Anova, and two pair T tests.

The students got a first-hand experience of Sound recording during TV program production and were explained how different camera angles and sound were selected while shooting a program. After that they were taken to the Camera room, where they were shown the Technicolour camera and Professional camera with different lenses. Finally, the students were taken to the Re-recording theatre, where dubbing takes place after the shooting of a movie or serial has been completed.

BSCIT/CS IT FEST - Festinobits




Date:27 - 28th January 2023
